2022 - Versailles declaration & Strategic Compass for Security & Defence

• 11.03: **Commitment** to take more responsibility for EU's own security in view of Russia's war of aggression

 22.03: Common strategic vision to strengthen EU's security & defence by 2030 based on 4 pillars: ACT -SECURE - INVEST - PARTNER

2023 - ASAP & EDIRPA

 20.07 : EU Regulation on supporting ammunition production (ASAP) (Expired 30.06.25)

 18.10: EU Regulation on establishing an instrument for the reinforcement of the EU defense industry through common procurement (EDIRPA) (Expires 31.12.25)

2024 - EU Defence Industrial Strategy (EDIS)

- 05.03 : Joint Communication setting the EU defence industrial policy until 2035 with a focus on competitiveness & readiness

2024 - EU Defence Industrial Program (EDIP)

• 05.03: Proposal for an EL Regulation establishing the EDIP

On 23 June 2025, the Council of the EU adopted its negotiating mandate for talks with the EU Parliament on the proposed EDIP.



Q1 2025 - White Paper for EU Defence Readiness 2030 & ReArm Europe Plan

19.03: White Paper sets the priorities & unlocks up to EUR 800 billion for an expenditure surge on European defence ("Spend better, together and European") including via the activation of the national escape clause of the Stability & Growth Pact
